Health Professions Student Development Certificate Requirements

Healthcare Competency Development

- 5 Competency Areas: Oral Communication, Written Communication,
 Cultural Awareness, Ethical Responsibility, and Leadership & Business
- 18 Total Credit Hours
 - 2 Courses from one competency area; 1 Course from each of the remaining four competency areas.
 - 9 hours must be advanced credit (3000/4000)
- Must earn a B or better in each course
- Must have a 3.25 Overall GPA at the time of certificate completion

Community Service

- 100 hours of healthcare volunteering and/or community service
- A log of hours with signatures must be submitted as proof

Healthcare Experience

- 50 hours of shadowing a professional (or professionals) within the field of interest
- A log of hours with signatures must be submitted as proof

Application Awareness & Enhancement

- Must attend three health professions workshops or related activities offered through the Office of Health Professions, and submit the appropriate documentation (i.e. proof of attendance).
 - Examples include: "What Should I Be Doing Now?" Seminars,
 Application Seminars, HPAC Seminars, Personal Statement
 Workshops, Mock Interview with a Health Professions Counselor,
 Guest Speakers, Health Professions 'Spring Swing' Academic Fair
- Must submit a 5000-character essay (includes spaces) addressing what you
 have learned from all categories of the certificate and how your overall
 experience will make you a strong healthcare professional.
