OVERVIEW

This report presents medical school admissions data from the Entry Year 2025 application cycle. **136 applicants**, who listed UNT as their primary institution, applied to various institutions across the nation, using the following application services: American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS), American Medical College Application Service (AMCAS), Texas Medical and Dental Schools Application Service (TMDSAS).

Out of the 136 unique applicants who applied, **43 matriculated (31.6%)** to a medical school and **8 deferred (5.9%)** their matriculation to Fall 2026. Of the 51 who matriculated or deferred, **69%** were first-time applicants, **29%** were second-time applicants, and **2%** were third-time applicants.



HPAC PARTICIPATION

Of the **51** students who matriculated into or deferred their acceptance to a medical school, **31 (61%)** participated in our Health Professions Advisory Committee (HPAC) program. In 2024, HPAC introduced a quantitative assessment to evaluate new participants. Of the 31 listed above, **12 (39%)** were considered "First Time Applicants" in 2024 and were evaluated using the new assessment. The remaining **19 (61%)** were First Time Applicants in a previous cycle and therefore were not evaluated with this assessment.
