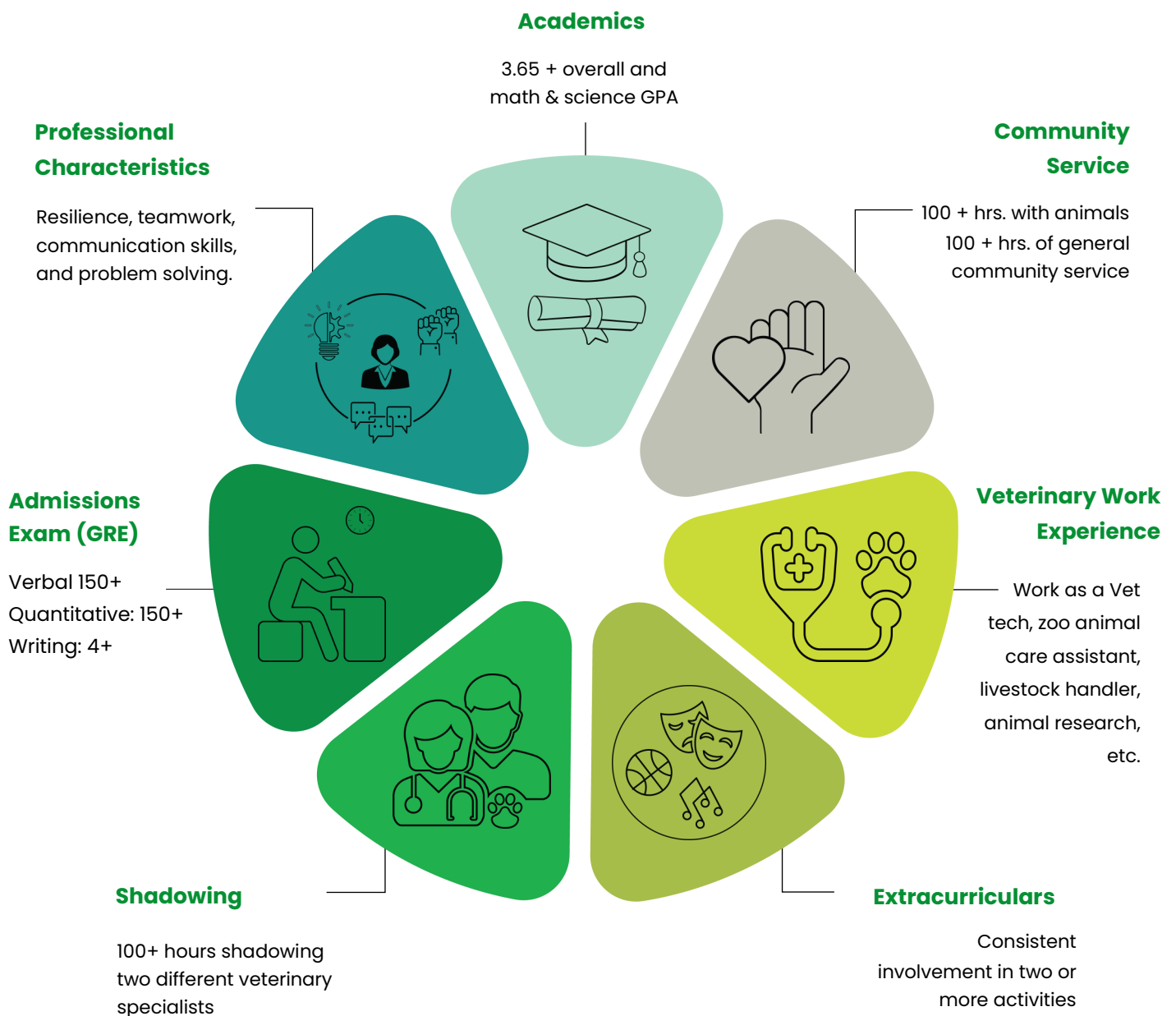


# Veterinary School Competitive Application
